



Hurricane Ian: Moving Forward with Recovery

To help survivors move forward effectively after disaster, national nonprofit organization SBP has tools and training available to help navigate the complex recovery processes, avoid costly mistakes and make smart decisions that will lead to a faster recovery. SBP's resources include free survivor info sessions and training on how to get started, as well as resource guides on key recovery topics.

SBP partners with local organizations and employers (such as health systems, retailers, manufacturers, schools & universities, community associations, etc.) to offer free sessions and share resource guides with impacted community members. Sessions can be scheduled in-person in service areas or via webinar, for 30-minute overview or 60-minute in-depth presentations.

Sessions also provide a forum for community members to ask questions, troubleshoot issues, and share tips and recommendations.
